Exporting texts, importing audio

Podcatcher's Content Management System, the TourEditor offers a clear view of all texts of all audio clips including the desired file name per clip.

If the studio supplies the files using this naming convention, it is possible to import all audio in one go.

Exporting texts

Click the (...) button next to the tour.

On the left a list of languages appears under "Audio texts".

Click the desired language to show the texts.

The clips of each object are shown. Each clip shows the filename and text.

You can print the page or copy and paste it to your own word processor.

Your Podcatcher will guide you along your tour through the building. On the device, you will find 3 buttons. The left button will decrease audio volume; the right button will increase volume. You can use the middle button to pause the information, and to start it again.
On entering a room, you may start the information by pointing the Podcatcher at an activation point within 1 meter of it, in the same way as you would use a remote control. There is no need to press any buttons; the information will be played immediately.
