

PODCATCHER : SYNC COMPUTER

Sync computer

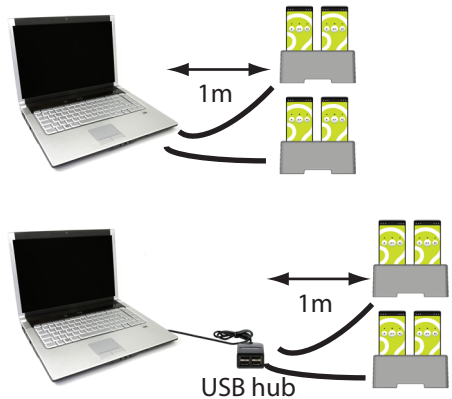
The content on the Podcatchers is synchronized daily with the Guide ID server over the internet. This requires a Windows PC with internet connection to which all Docks are connected. This PC runs the Podcatcher Sync application.

System requirements

- PC with 1 GHz processor (minimum)
- At least 1 GB main memory
- Enough free harddisk space for content
- Windows XP / Vista / 7 (including all the latest updates)
- Windows Update enabled
- .NET Framework 3.5 SP1
- At least 1 available USB 2.0 connection (expandable by USB2.0 hub)
- Broadband internet connection
- Must be online 24/7
- The Sync application requires administrator privileges to run

Placement

The Dock must be placed within 1 meter of the PC or USB hub.



Frequently asked questions

- *Can a netbook or laptop be used?*

Yes, as long as it meets the system requirements netbooks and laptops can be used. Given the small size they are even recommended.

- *Is access to the internal network required for storage of files?*

No, all files are stored on the internal harddisk of the Sync computer. Network connection is only required to gain access to the internet.

- *What data is being sent over the internet?*

The Sync software gets the content (audio files) from the Guide ID server and sends back logfiles from the Podcatchers.

- *Can the computer be used to work on?*

No, the computer can only be used to synchronize the Podcatchers.

- *Can Windows update still be enabled?*

Yes, as long as the computer restarts and logs in automatically after installing the updates.
